PURPOSE: Reduces by \$4.0 million General Fund the appropriation to the Department of **Human Services** for housing assistance for individuals with substance use disorders. Adds \$4.0 million total funds, including \$2.0 million General Fund, to the Department of **Health Care Policy and Financing** to partially offset the implementation of post eligibility-treatment of income for the Adult Comprehensive (DD) waiver. Adds \$2.0 million General Fund to the Department of **Local Affairs** for low income rental subsidies.
