 2 substitute "Residence^{16a}", in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike
 3 "6,619,924 and substitute "6,457,424", and in the GENERAL FUND
 4 column strike "6,012,928" and substitute "5,850,428".

5 Adjust affected totals accordingly.

6 Page 124, after line 4 insert:

9 16a Governor - Lieutenant Governor - State Planning and
 10 Budgeting, Office of the Governor, Governor's Office,
 11 Administration of Governor's Office and Residence -- It is

 13 used for the Office of Saving People Money on Health
 14 Care after January 11, 2027."

15 Page 469, line 8, in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike "7,730,013"
 16 and substitute "7,892,513" and in the GENERAL FUND column insert
 17 "162,500".

18 Adjust affected totals accordingly.

PURPOSE: Reduces the appropriation to the Administration of the Governor's Office and Residence line item in the Office of the **Governor** by \$162,500 General Fund and increases the appropriation to the Colorado Automobile Theft Protection Authority in the Department of **Public Safety** by the same amount. Also includes a footnote in the Office of the **Governor** expressing legislative intent that the appropriation not be used for the Office of Saving People Money on Health Care after the beginning of the next gubernatorial term.
