HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Appropriations.

HB26-1138 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, line 2, strike "office of the attorney general,"  
2 and substitute "division of criminal justice in the department of public  
3 safety,".

4 Page 3, strike line 7 and substitute "division of criminal justice;".

5 Page 3, line 15, strike "24-31-120" and substitute "24-33.5-540".

6 Page 3, line 17, strike "~~24-31-120.~~" and substitute "~~24-31-120.~~" and substitute "**24-33.5-540.**".

7 Page 4, line 12, strike "OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL," and  
8 substitute "DIVISION,".

9 Page 6, strike lines 19 and 20 and substitute "(4). GRANTS MUST BE PAID  
10 OUT OF MONEY APPROPRIATED PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-33.5-117 (7) OR  
11 FROM GIFTS, GRANTS, OR DONATIONS RECEIVED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION  
12 (4)(e) OF THIS SECTION.".

13 Page 7, after line 3 insert:

14 "(5) THE DIVISION MAY ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL  
15 OPERATING AGREEMENT WITH THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE FOR THE  
16 ADVISORY BOARD AND THE COLORADO RETAIL THEFT TASK FORCE TO  
17 SHARE RESOURCES AND COORDINATE ACTIVITIES RELATED TO REDUCING  
18 ORGANIZED FELONY-LEVEL THEFT IN THE STATE.".

19 Renumber succeeding subsections accordingly.

20 Page 7, strike lines 11 through 15 and substitute:

21 "(c) THE NUMBER OF CRIMINAL CASES INITIATED FOR ORGANIZED  
22 FELONY-LEVEL RETAIL THEFT AS REPORTED BY DISTRICT ATTORNEYS AND  
23 THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE, INCLUDING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY  
24 SOUGHT IN EACH CASE; AND

25 (d) THE OUTCOME OF EACH CASE INITIATED FOR ORGANIZED  
26 FELONY-LEVEL RETAIL THEFT.".

27 Page 7, after line 16 insert:

28 "**SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-117, **amend**  
29 (7) and (9) as follows:

1           **24-33.5-117. Crime prevention through safer streets grant**  
2 **program - created - committee - reports - repeal.**

3           (7) (a) The general assembly shall appropriate ten million three  
4 hundred thousand dollars in fiscal year 2022-23 from the general fund for  
5 the grant program AND THE RETAIL THEFT PREVENTION GRANT PROGRAM  
6 CREATED IN SECTION 24-33.5-540. Any unexpended money remaining at  
7 the end of ~~the 2022-23~~ A state fiscal year from this appropriation may be  
8 used by the department until fully expended without further appropriation  
9 and must not be used for any other purpose other than the purposes set  
10 forth in this section AND SECTION 24-33.5-540.

11           (b) ON JULY 1, 2027, TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS OF THE  
12 UNEXPENDED AND UNENCUMBERED MONEY REMAINING AT THE END OF  
13 THE 2026-27 STATE FISCAL YEAR FROM THE APPROPRIATION MADE  
14 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (7)(a) OF THIS SECTION REVERTS TO THE  
15 GENERAL FUND AND IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR FURTHER EXPENDITURE BY  
16 THE DEPARTMENT.

17           (9) This section is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2027~~ NOVEMBER 1,  
18 2029."

19   Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

20   Strike "ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE" and substitute "DIVISION" on: **Page**  
21 **6**, line 6 and 23; and **Page 7**, line 5.

22   Page 1, lines 104 and 105, strike "OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL."  
23   and substitute "DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE."
