

HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Appropriations.

HB26-1273 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 5, before line 1 insert:

2 **"SECTION 2. Appropriation - adjustments to 2026 long bill.**

3 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, to implement this
4 act, the general fund appropriation made in the annual general
5 appropriation act for the 2026-27 state fiscal year to the department of
6 labor and employment for use by the division of labor standards and
7 statistics for program costs related to labor standards is decreased by
8 \$16,343, and the related FTE is decreased by 0.1 FTE.

9 (2) Subsection (1) of this section does not require a reduction of
10 an appropriation in the annual general appropriation act for the 2026-27
11 state fiscal year if:

12 (a) The amount of the general fund appropriation made in the
13 annual general appropriation act for the 2026-27 state fiscal year to the
14 department of labor and employment for use by the division of labor
15 standards and statistics for program costs related to labor standards is less
16 than the amount of the adjustment required in subsection (1) of this
17 section; or

18 (b) The annual general appropriation act for the 2026-27 state
19 fiscal year does not include an appropriation to the department of labor
20 and employment for use by the division of labor standards and statistics
21 for program costs related to labor standards."

22 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

23 Page 5, after line 10 insert:

24 "(2) Section 2 of this act takes effect only if the annual general
25 appropriation act for the 2026-27 state fiscal year becomes law, in which
26 case section 2 takes effect upon the effective date of this act or of the
27 annual general appropriation act for state fiscal year 2026-27, whichever
28 is later."

29 Renumber succeeding paragraph accordingly.

30 Page 1, line 104, strike "COMPANY." and substitute "COMPANY, AND, IN
31 CONNECTION THEREWITH, REDUCING AN APPROPRIATION."
