

# An Act

HOUSE BILL 26-1218

BY REPRESENTATIVE(S) Espenoza and Luck, Bradley, Carter;  
also SENATOR(S) Catlin and Ball, Coleman.

CONCERNING CLARIFYING THE VALIDITY OF COMMON LAW MARRIAGE BY  
RESTORING A PREVIOUSLY REPEALED PROVISION.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 14-2-104, **recreate and reenact, with amendments, (3)** as follows:

**14-2-104. Formalities.**

(3) THIS SECTION DOES NOT REPEAL OR INVALIDATE ANY OTHERWISE  
VALID COMMON LAW MARRIAGE:

(a) ENTERED INTO PRIOR TO SEPTEMBER 1, 2006; OR

(b) ENTERED INTO ON OR AFTER SEPTEMBER 1, 2006, AND COMPLIES  
WITH SECTION 14-2-109.5.

**SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds,

determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state institutions.


