Committee on Judiciary.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB26-124 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and
2 substitute:

3 **"SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-539, **amend**
4 (4) as follows:
5 **24-33.5-539. Automated protection order notification system**
6 **- definitions.**

7 (4) The Colorado bureau of investigation in the division AND THE
8 COLORADO INTEGRATED CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM
9 PROGRAM CREATED IN SECTION 16-20.5-103 shall make the information
10 described in subsection (3) of this section available to the division for the
11 purpose of providing the information to a protected person, the protected
12 person's immediate family, or other interested persons pursuant to
13 subsection (2) of this section.

14 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
15 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
16 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
17 12, 2026, if adjournment sine die is on May 13, 2026); except that, if a
18 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
19 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
20 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
21 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
22 November 2026 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
23 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor."

24 Page 1, strike lines 101 and 102 and substitute "**CONCERNING**
25 **REQUIRING THE COLORADO INTEGRATED CRIMINAL JUSTICE**
26 **INFORMATION SYSTEM PROGRAM TO MAKE INFORMATION AVAILABLE**

1 FOR THE AUTOMATED PROTECTION ORDER NOTIFICATION SYSTEM."
