After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB26-189 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 21, line 26, strike "OTHER LAW." and substitute
2 "EXISTING LAW."

3 Page 22, line 1, strike "**other law.**" and substitute "**existing law.**".

4 Page 22, line 13, strike "OTHER LAW." and substitute "EXISTING LAW."

5 Page 22, line 16, strike "OTHER LAW." and substitute "EXISTING LAW."

6 Page 22, lines 23 and 24, strike "OTHER LAW." and substitute "EXISTING
7 LAW."

8 Page 22, line 26, strike "OTHER LAW" and substitute "EXISTING LAW".

9 Page 28, strike lines 18 and 19 and substitute:

10 **"SECTION 4. Effective date - applicability.**

11 (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2) of this section,
12 this act takes effect January 1, 2027.

13 (2) Sections 6-1-1704 (4), 6-1-1705 (3), and 6-1-1706 (6),
14 Colorado Revised Statutes, as amended in section 1 of this act, and
15 section 10-3-1104.9 (3)(e), Colorado Revised Statutes, as amended in
16 section 3 of this act, take effect upon passage.

17 (3) This act applies to consequential decisions made on or after
18 the effective date of this act."
