 - 14 **24-31-101. Powers and duties of attorney general - services**
 - 15 **related to supporting outside counsel - rules."**
- 16 Page 77, strike lines 16 through 27.
- 17 Page 78, strike line 1.
- 18 Renumber succeeding subsection accordingly.
- 19 Page 83, after line 27 insert:
 - 20 **"SECTION 106.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-5-429, **amend**
 - 21 **as added by House Bill 26-1135** (5) as follows:
 - 22 **25-5-429. Chemicals used in hair relaxers and hair pieces -**
 - 23 **warning labels - deceptive trade practice - short title - definitions.**
 - 24 (5) A violation of this section by a manufacturer constitutes a
 - 25 deceptive trade practice under ~~section 6-1-105-13 (1)(qqqq)~~ ARTICLE 1 OF

- 28 Page 84, line 1, strike "**date.** This" and substitute "**date.** (1) Except as
- 29 otherwise provided in subsection (2) of this section, this".
- 30 Page 84, after line 10 insert:
 - 31 "(2) Section 25-5-429 (5), Colorado Revised Statutes, as amended
 - 32 in section 106 of this act, takes effect only if House Bill 26-1135 becomes
 - 33 law, in which case section 25-5-429 (5), Colorado Revised Statutes, as
 - 34 amended in section 106 of this act, takes effect on the effective date of
 - 35 this act or House Bill 26-1135, whichever is later."
